How do large and small animals' cells 'know' how big to make their bones?

We are looking for a Postdoctoral Researcher to join an interdisciplinary team bridging basic bone biology (Michael Doube, Isabel Orriss, Andy Pitsillides, Skeletal Biology Group, Camden Campus) and evolutionary comparative biomechanics (John R Hutchinson, Structure and Motion Laboratory, Hawkshead Campus).

You will lead the day to day running of this project, in which you will isolate, culture and assay the bone formation and resorption activities of bone cells (osteoblasts and osteoclasts) from animals of widely differing size and taxonomy. Starting with domestic animals and expanding into exotic species through our zoo collaborators, you will analyse trends and relationships between in vitro bone cell behaviour and the size of the animal from which cells were taken.

The ideal candidate will have a PhD in biology with a strong emphasis on animal cell/tissue culture. You must have a high level of skill in experimental design, data handling and statistics with the ability to work effectively on your own but also as part of a team. A willingness to travel to field locations will also be a must with this role.

**9th International Symposium on Nutritional Aspects of Osteoporosis
17-20 June 2015, Montreal, Canada**

The 9th International Symposium on Nutritional Aspects of Osteoporosis will be held in Montreal, Canada on the 17-20th June 2015. This symposium is the only international meeting which deals exclusively with nutrition, bone and muscle, and usually attracts about 120 specialists from all over the world. In 2015 the meeting will move from Lausanne, Switzerland to North America for the first time. The meeting is being organized by Prof. Connie Weaver from Purdue University in the USA, Prof. Robin Daly from Deakin University in Australia, and Prof. Heike Bischoff-Ferrari from the University of Zurich in Switzerland. This symposium will be of great interest to many health professionals across various disciplines because of the emphasis on bone and other tissues including muscle and the brain, and recent evidence for a role of protein, potassium, B vitamins, vitamin D, omega 3 fatty acids and flavonoids on bone and muscle health, as well as the interactions between bone and other conditions such as diabetes and chronic kidney disease. To address the challenges of an aging population, the role of nutrition will be reviewed specifically for the prevention of sarcopenia, frailty and their consequences (falls, hip fractures, loss of autonomy).
