9th International Symposium on Nutritional Aspects of Osteoporosis

17-20 June 2015, Montreal, Canada

The 9th International Symposium on Nutritional Aspects of Osteoporosis will be held in Montreal, Canada on the 17-20th June 2015. This symposium is the only international meeting which deals exclusively with nutrition, bone and muscle, and usually attracts about 120 specialists from all over the world. In 2015 the meeting will move from Lausanne, Switzerland to North America for the first time. The meeting is being organized by Prof. Connie Weaver from Purdue University in the USA, Prof. Robin Daly from Deakin University in Australia, and Prof. Heike Bischoff-Ferrari from the University of Zurich in Switzerland. This symposium will be of great interest to many health professionals across various disciplines because of the emphasis on bone and other tissues including muscle and the brain, and recent evidence for a role of protein, potassium, B vitamins, vitamin D, omega 3 fatty acids and flavonoids on bone and muscle health, as well as the interactions between bone and other conditions such as diabetes and chronic kidney disease. To address the challenges of an aging population, the role of nutrition will be reviewed specifically for the prevention of sarcopenia, frailty and their consequences (falls, hip fractures, loss of autonomy).
