The program is designed to fund projects that generally fall outside the parameters of other funding sources, and supports projects that:

Evaluate the quality use of medicines in the treatment of osteoporosis

OR

Advance the prevention, diagnosis or management of osteoporosis.

Projects that are wholly or substantially based on basic laboratory research are not eligible for this program.
